 - Operations plan
 - Menu or product overview (if applicable)
 - Marketing and promotional approach
- 3. Design and layout plan including use of kitchen/bar (if applicable)
- 4. Experience and qualifications of operator/team
- 5. Financial proposal, including proposed rent, investment commitment, and pro forma financials
- 6. Timeline for buildout and opening

Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Innovation and uniqueness of concept
- Compatibility with Navy Pier's audience and current mix of offerings
- Experience and qualifications of operator
- Financial strength and feasibility
- Quality of design and guest experience
